

Track Limits Regulations

You need to be aware of the track limits regulations and comply with them.

Motorsport UK Regulation Q12.21.2:

Drivers must use the track at all times and may not leave the track without a justifiable reason. For the avoidance of doubt:

(a) The white lines defining the track edges are considered to be part of the track.

(b) A driver will be judged to have left the track if any wheel of the car either goes beyond the outer edge of any kerb or goes beyond the white line where there is no kerb.

Penalties including those listed in Q12.22.1 can be imposed.

Additionally, note that Motorsport UK Regulation Q12.21.4 states:

12.21.4. Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or **the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track)** will be reported to the Clerk of Course and **may entail the imposition of penalties** up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.
